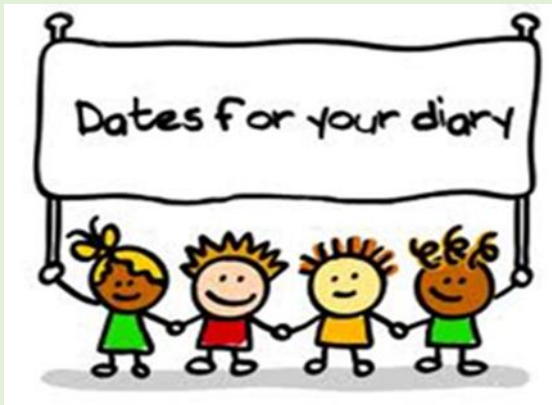
## *School Uniforms*
