Expressive Art and Design

- Use drawing to represent movements and sounds*
- Remember and sing entire songs*

- Drawing aliens, planets and rockets

Maths

- Fast recognition of up to 3 objects*
- Saying one number name for each item in order*
- Know that the last number is the total*
- Understand position through words alone*
- Counting games
- Practise recognising small quantities without counting
- Number puzzles
- Using position words (such as on, under, behind) during free play and tidy up times

Literacy

- Develop phonological awareness*
- Identifying sounds
- Recognising rhyming words through reading rhyming stories
- Discussing initial sounds in words
