Inter-Faith Week

What an important opportunity for us to focus on the core values of our faiths, when the world is caught up in such a complex, worrying and traumatic time. It is our hope that we can explain clearly to our pupils that a mutual respect of each other's faith is paramount - that we respect each other as people with or without faith, and that violence has no part in the core values of any faith or nation.




