FREE SCHOOL MEALS SPACES - During the Easter holidays SSG will be offering fully funded spaces on their Active Childcare programme to families who are eligible for Free School Meals. They are working with Bedford Borough Council to offer these places free of charge. Children aged 5-12 years will be able to access this provision on the following dates: Tuesday 2<sup>nd</sup> April to Thursday 11<sup>th</sup> April, 9AM-5PM each day and will be provided free lunch they attend. There will be a range of activities including inflatable fun, outdoor adventure and challenge, arts and crafts, multi-sports and more!

The scheme will be run from two venues, Ursula Taylor C of E School, Clapham, Bedford MK41 6EG, and from Westfield Primary School, Chester Road, Queens Park, Bedford MK40 4HW.
