Who is Jewish?



We will be learning to understand that data can be represented in picture format. We will contribute to a whole class pictogram and use a pictogram to record the results of an experiment.

Gymnastics:

We will learn to use space safely and effectively. We will explore and develop basic gymnastic actions on the floor and using low apparatus. Basic skills of jumping, rolling, balancing and travelling are used individually and in combination to create movement phrases. We will also give the children opportunities to select their own actions to build short sequences and develop their confidence in performing.

Target Games:

We will develop our understanding of the principles of defending and attacking for target games. Pupils use both underarm and overarm actions and are given opportunities to select and apply the appropriate action for the target considering the size and distance of the challenge.
