Excellent End

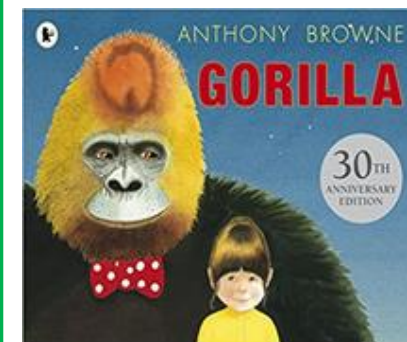
Pupils will present their dioramas that they have been working on through the term.
