Children will be taught to –

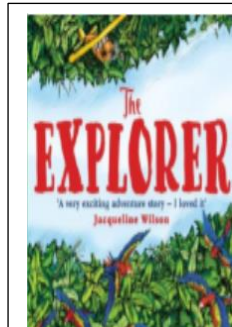
- To use the serve with consideration of attacking principles.
