



## Maths

### **Percentages**

#### ***Pupils will be taught:***

writing percentages  
equivalent fractions, percentages and decimals  
comparing portions using percentages

### **Geometry-properties of shapes**

#### ***Pupils will be taught to:***

measure angles,  
investigate angles on a line/point  
draw angles,  
use angles as a descriptor for common shapes  
solve problems involving angles  
investigate angles inside regular polygons

### **Geometry-position direction/movement**

#### ***Pupils will be taught to:***

name and plot points  
describe the position of a shape following a translation  
describe movements and reflecting shapes  
describe the position of a shape following a reflection  
reflect a shape more than once

## Science: Living things and their habitats

Children will learn about the process of reproduction and the life cycles of plants, mammals, amphibians, insects and birds. They will have the opportunity to take cuttings from plants, creating clones of the parent plant. They will find out about Jane Goodall and her work with the now-endangered chimpanzees.

## PE

### **Cricket**

Pupils develop their understanding of striking and fielding. They expand on their knowledge of the different roles of bowler, wicket keeper, fielder and batter. They will have to think about how they use skills, strategies and tactics to outwit the opposition.

## PSHE

### **Healthy and Safer Lifestyles**

Pupils will explore situations where they have responsibility for their own safety and that of others. They will learn ways of getting help from known and unknown adults in an emergency and identify situations where they might encounter risk and have strategies to stay safe.

## Religious Education

### ***What do Christians believe Jesus did to "save" people?***

Children will explore the last days of Jesus' life starting with the Last Supper.

## MFL - German

### **Pupils will be taught to:**

follow general class instructions during the school day in German  
count in multiples of ten up to one hundred  
use some adjectives (with or without endings)  
recognise and say key words in a German song
