#### IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR PARENTS

## \*School Penalty Notices\*

Regular and punctual attendance at school is the law, and it is the responsibility of parents and carers to ensure their child/children is in school. If a child does not attend school and they do not have permission from the school for the absence, the parent or carer may be issued with a School Penalty Notice.

## \*When is a School Penalty Notice issued?\*

A School Penalty Notice may be issued:

- when the pupil has taken holiday during term-time and the absence has not been authorised by the school
- following a Truancy Patrol when the school has recorded the absence of the pupil as unauthorised
- if a pupil is persistently late for school
- if a pupil's school attendance has been poor, and the parents/carers fail to attend or cooperate at pre-referral meetings

The Education Welfare Service will issue a School Penalty Notice if at least 5 school days (10 sessions) have been missed due to unauthorised absence during the last 12 school weeks.

Once a School Penalty Notice has been issued, there is no statutory right of appeal, although there are circumstances in which the Council may withdraw it.

## \*How much is a School Penalty Notice?\*

A School Penalty Notice is £80 if paid within 21 days, rising to £160 if paid after 21 days but within 28 days.

Late or part payments will not be accepted. We do not send reminders. If you do not pay the School Penalty Notice you are likely to be prosecuted for the offence and could be fined up to £2,500.

## \*How to pay a School Penalty Notice\*

School Penalty Notices are issued by the Borough Council on behalf of the school, and the penalty fines are paid to the council NOT the school

The quickest and easiest way to pay is online. You will need:

- your School Penalty Notice reference number (this is on the front of your School Penalty Notice)
- your credit or debit card

They do not accept cash, cheques, or postal orders.
