

Maths

Pupils begin solving more complex word problems involving multiple operations, including multiplication and division

Pupils are then challenged by finding common multiples and common factors before ending the unit exploring prime numbers.

Pupils learn about adding, subtracting, multiplying and dividing fractions

Pupils move to dividing and multiplying decimals by 1 and 2-digit numbers with no regrouping or renaming and converting between fractions and decimals
